Construction Begins

The clearing and grading portion of Phase 1 at Empire Lakes started in May 1963 in preparation for constructing the first two buildings on the new campus. Throughout its 50-year history, each time an expansion was undertaken, the ubiquitous water, mud, brush, stumps and trees were obstacles that had to be overcome. Donald W. Thompson was awarded the contract for constructing the first two buildings on the campus for a bid price of \$300,180. The footings were poured that same fall and students began occupying the two new buildings in the spring of 1964.
